CHINESE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP-CHINESE UNIVERSITY PROGRAM	
Program Introduction	Chinese Government Scholarship--Chinese University Program is a full scholarship established by Ministry of Education to support Chinese universities in specific provinces or autonomous regions to enroll outstanding international students for graduate studies in China.
Eligibility	This scholarship only supports graduate programs. The applicant should be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China, and be in good health; the applicant should not be a registered student in Chinese universities at the time of application; or be a graduate from Chinese universities for more than one year; the applicant should: - be a bachelor's degree holder under the age of 35 when applying for master's programs; - be a master's degree holder under the age of 40 when applying for doctoral programs.
Scholarship Coverage	- Tuition waiver - Accommodation - Living stipend - Medical insurance
Application Procedures	1. Submit online application at CSC Online Application System http://laihua.csc.edu.cn . 2. Download and print out 2 copies of the application form after filling in. CUG (Wuhan) agency code is 10491. 3. Send all the required application documents to the university before the deadline.

Application Period	Jan 1st - April 15th
Approval & Notification	The university will review the application documents and decide the nominated candidates before the end of May. The list of nominated candidates will be sent to CSC for review and approval. Before the end of July, Admission Letter and Visa Application Form for Study in China (JW201) will be sent out from the university to the approved scholarship winners.
